Versatile's promise to you.

To Our Valued Customers,

Following the Mandatory Vaccination regulations announced by the Premier Mark McGowan, all Versatile Mitre 10 staff and contractors that are scheduled to visit building sites including offices, residential or commercial will be double vaccinated by the 31st of January 2022.

These staff include:

- Account Managers/Sales Representatives
- Management Team
- Delivery Drivers (Included any contracted delivery drivers)
- Any other VBP staff

As highlighted in the Building and Construction Industry regulations, Versatile Mitre 10 is ensuring all staff are fully vaccinated should a lock down occur as a result of an outbreak of COVID -19.

Versatile Mitre 10 will not be sending out proof of vaccinations or registers for our employee's current vaccination status. All copies of vaccination have been provided to management. Our employees and contractors however will present evidence of their vaccination status upon request on site.

As stated, there are penalties of \$20,000 for individuals and \$100,000 for companies that do not comply with the mandatory vaccination requirements.
